Whole-Systems Strategic Team Action Planning (TAP) is a framework that taps into the wisdom of all team members to take individual creativity into group action. The "soak time" between sessions will allow us to fully process all views. This solution-oriented planning process allows a servant leader to engage the entire team in developing a shared vision, dealing with obstacles and implementing specific actions grounded in a long-term strategic view.
